

What is Thanksgiving?


It is a holiday in the United States where we show gratitude for what and who we have in our lives.






Why do we celebrate It?




Who were the Pilgrims?




The Pilgrims were a separatist, religious group who left England in order to find religious freedom in the New Word.

- -Most Wampanoag died because of smallpox and wars.


Controversies
