First settlers:

 - -> Nomads

 - After 1200 BC Celtics came about, who Romans fought against



Ancient Scotland

- 80 AD Romans conquered Scotland
- Realised it was impossible to control the land
- Built Hadrian's wall to protect Romans from the Scots





Rulers

- Before the English invaded Scotland was ruled by vikings and Lords
- In 1296 English king Edward I invaded Scotland
 Now Scotland is ruled by England
 - -> Many Scots were unhappy





William Wallace

- Famous Scot who resisted the English conquering
- Beat the English in battle of Stirling bridge in 1297
- Was defeated in battle of Falkirk in 1298
 - -> Executed in 1305



Robert the Bruce

- Another Scot who fought against English
- Won the battle of Bannockburn in 1314
- Ensured Scottish freedom and independence for around 400 years

Was crowned the King of Scotland

Mary Queen of Scots

Became queen when she was 6 days old as her father died

Spent her childhood in France, then moved back to Scotland to rule in 1561

In 1567 was forced to abdicate

In 1587 beheaded by Queen Elizabeth I of England



Great Britain

- In 1603 King James VI of Scotland inherited English throne
- In 1707 Great Britain was formed
- Scotland and England are now ruled together by one King/Queen
